What is Zinio?

Zinio is a mobile reading application that delivers digital editions of magazines. It provides the same reading material plus exclusive video, audio and web links.

Zinio may be used on an iPhone, iPad, or Android device, as well as your desktop or laptop, some phones and e-readers. Free apps are available in app stores or through the Zinio.com website.

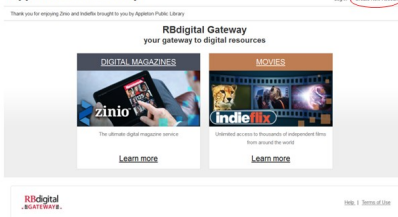
The Appleton Public Library provides access to many different magazine titles. You need a valid InfoSoup library card & PIN plus an email account to get started with Zinio.

Access Zinio with your Card

Go to www.apl.org and click on the Zinio icon down the page on the right. The RBdigital gateway will open.



2. In the upper right, click **Create New Account** to create your Appleton Public Library/Zinio account. It uses your Infosoup card number to set up the account.



Click **Create Account**. Enter your library card number (no spaces) and click **Next**.

Follow instructions to create a Zinio Account.

The next time you access Zinio.com you will just sign in with your email and password.

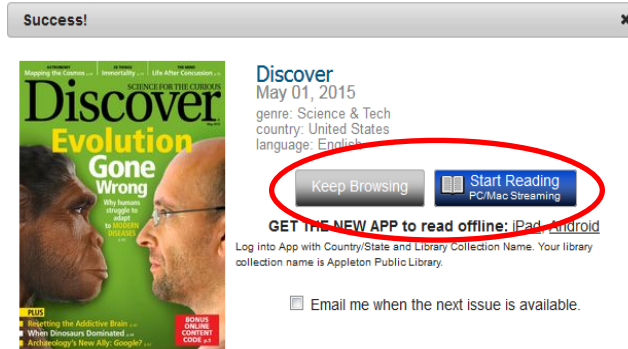
Click a magazine cover to see full information, or



to get the issue right away, click **Checkout**.

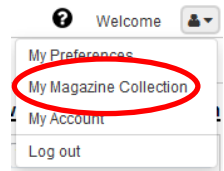


You can **Keep Browsing** if you wish to look for more magazines, or **Start Reading** to open the issue.



You **must** create your account and choose magazine issues through the www.apl.org website to receive them without charge, and need to sign in to the app or the Zinio.com web page to view an issue.

You can delete and restore issues through the RBdigital gateway in the account menu (upper right corner). Go to My Magazine Collection.



Zinio for Libraries App



You can use the free Zinio for Libraries app to view magazine issues on your mobile device.

Download from your app store, available for Apple, Android or Windows 8 devices.

Open the app and sign in. The first time using the app, you will be prompted to input your country, state, and library.

***Note:** The app is a **reader only**. To download magazines, follow the directions to [Access Zinio With Your Card](#).

***For devices not yet compatible with this app, the commercial Zinio app will access library magazines once a separate account for the app is created. No purchase is necessary. For assistance on downloading apps, go to <http://www.zinio.com/help/>**
